ORDER

Robin Leach, Jr., seeks to appeal his sentence. The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Leach's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the plea agreement and the transcript of the Fed. R. Crim. P. 11 hearing, we conclude that Leach knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the issue Leach seeks to raise on appeal falls squarely within the compass of his waiver of appellate rights. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
