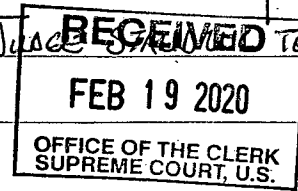

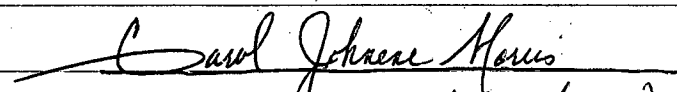

CONVICTIONS AND SENTENCES, BE HEREBY GRANTED.

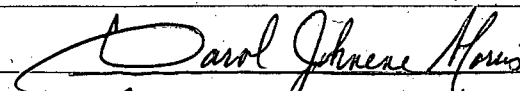

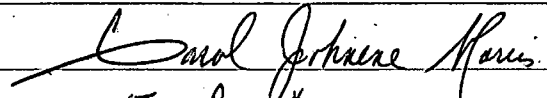
