I am in receipt of your January 8, 2020 correspondence. I represent respondent Michael Vickers in the above-referenced matter.

According to your correspondence, the Court desires a response brief to be filed on or before February 7, 2020.

I respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension of time pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4.

The reasons for the request are the following:

- 1) On January 15, 2020, I have a pre-trial conference in the United States District for the Southern District of Georgia with regard to a case that is being tried in February;
- 2) On January 17, 2020, I am currently scheduled to participate in a mediation in the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
