Dear Mr. Harris,

Petitioner's petition in the above-captioned case was docketed on November 26, 2019. The Court called for a response on January 13, 2020, and Respondents filed their brief in opposition on March 13, 2020. The first distribution date after the 14-day period under Supreme Court Rule 15.5 appears to be April 1, 2020.

Pursuant to the Court's Order of March 19, 2020, addressing the extension of deadlines, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court delay the distribution of this petition for writ of certiorari until the April 28, 2020 distribution date. Petitioner requires the additional time for two reasons, both caused by the COVID pandemic. First, counsel has experienced symptoms that may be COVID related, and is attempting to rest as much as possible in order to prevent his symptoms from worsening. Second, due to work disruptions and the closure of elementary schools in Chicago, counsel has been limited in his ability to review the case and prepare the reply. Petitioner has not previously sought an extension of time from this Court.
