Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully moves for an extension of the time for filing a response to the petition for writ of certiorari in *McGregor v. Texas*, No. 19-685.

The response is currently due on February 20, 2020. A 60-day extension, until April 2, 2020, is needed because undersigned counsel was not notified until yesterday, February 11, 2020, of the Fort Bend County District Attorney's request that the Office of the Attorney General assume representation of the State of Texas and respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case. Because my office is new to the case, and because we have not yet received the state-court records, additional time is needed to review the record and prepare a response that will assist the Court.

No prejudice would arise from the requested extension. Petitioner does not oppose this request.
