On behalf of the Respondent in this matter, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request a 20-day extension of time to respond to the Petition in this case. This would extend the current deadline from April 6, 2020 to April 27, 2020. In the time since this Court granted a first extension of 30 days for filing Florida's brief in opposition to the Petition, the deputy solicitor general responsible for drafting the brief in opposition has managed a heavy caseload, including filing three briefs in the Florida Supreme Court and multiple motions entailing a substantial expenditure of time.
