The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on December 27, 2019, and distributed for conference on January 16, 2020. On January 23, 2020, a response was requested. The State's response is due, after one extension, on March 25, 2020. I respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time of 21 days, to and including April 15, 2020, for the filing of the State's response.
