ORDER

RECOMMENDATION OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

Plaintiff, a prisoner of the State of North Carolina serving a sentence of life in prison following convictions for murder and arson, submitted a *pro se* Complaint [Doc. #1], along the \$400.00 filing fee and a number of other documents. Plaintiff names the "United States et al its three Branches" as the Defendant in the case and contends that a number of his constitutional rights have been or are being violated. Plaintiff's documents are rambling and somewhat difficult to decipher. However, they are all based on the contention that he is a "Moorish-American National" and that, because of this fact, neither North Carolina nor the United States of America has jurisdiction over him. He also relies on commercial, civil, and admiralty law in his pleadings. Plaintiff views his incarceration as violating his rights under the United States Constitution. Plaintiff seeks his release from prison, absolution from any past, present, or future state or federal charges, and \$100,000,000 on a credit card as relief.

Because Plaintiff is “a prisoner seek[ing] redress from a governmental entity or officer or employee of a governmental entity,” this Court has an obligation to “review” this Complaint. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(a). “On review, the court shall . . . dismiss the complaint, or any portion of the complaint, if [it] – (1) is frivolous, malicious, or fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted; or (2) seeks monetary relief from a defendant who is immune from such relief.” 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b).

As to the first basis for dismissal, the United States Supreme Court has explained that “a complaint, containing as it does both factual allegations and legal conclusions, is frivolous where it lacks an arguable basis either in law or in fact.” Neitzke v. Williams, 490 U.S. 319, 325 (1989). “The word ‘frivolous’ is inherently elastic and not susceptible to categorical definition. . . . The term’s capaciousness directs lower courts to conduct a flexible analysis, in light of the totality of the circumstances, of all factors bearing upon the frivolity of a claim.” Nagy v. Federal Med. Ctr. Butner, 376 F.3d 252, 256-57 (4th Cir. 2004) (some internal quotation marks omitted). As part of this review, the Court may anticipate affirmative defenses that clearly appear on the face of the complaint. Nasim v. Warden, Md. House of Corr., 64 F.3d 951, 954 (4th Cir. 1995) (en banc); Todd v. Baskerville, 712 F.2d 70, 74 (4th Cir. 1983).

The Supreme Court further has identified factually frivolous complaints as ones involving “allegations that are fanciful, fantastic, and delusional. As those words suggest, a finding of factual frivolousness is appropriate when the facts alleged rise to the level of the irrational or the wholly incredible, whether or not there are judicially noticeable facts available to contradict them.” Denton v. Hernandez, 504 U.S. 25, 32-33 (1992) (internal

citations and quotation marks omitted). In making such findings, this Court may “apply common sense.” Nasim, 64 F.3d at 954.

For the reasons that follow, the Complaint should be dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) because it is frivolous.

As an initial matter, the Court notes that Plaintiff is attempting to undermine his convictions or sentences for murder and arson. Plaintiff may not do so without first showing that such convictions were reversed on direct appeal, expunged by Executive Order, declared invalid by a state tribunal, or, finally, called into question by a federal court through the issuance of a writ of habeas corpus. Heck v. Humphrey, 512 U.S. 477 (1994). Plaintiff fails to do so and, therefore, dismissal is proper for this reason alone.

Further, Plaintiff previously attempted to attack his convictions in a habeas corpus petition under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 in case 1:16CV524 using essentially the same theories he raises here. The Court dismissed that case *sua sponte* on its merits and informed Plaintiff that commercial and civil law cannot be used to invalidate a criminal conviction or sentence and that a person’s nationality or ethnicity are not relevant to the validity of a conviction. Specifically, a person’s claimed identity as a Moorish American does not absolve them of criminal liability or prevent courts from exercising jurisdiction over them. See El-Bey v. United States, No. 1:08CV151, 2009 WL 1019999, at \*1 (M.D.N.C. Jan. 26, 2009) (unpublished) (collecting cases rejecting “Moorish” identity claims). Nevertheless, Plaintiff persists in raising this frivolous contention in the present action, apparently believing that he can simply declare himself a Moorish American National and avoid the



consequences for murder and any other crimes he has committed or may commit in the future. His claims are frivolous and should be dismissed.

In addition to the Complaint, Plaintiff also submitted several requests which were docketed as motions. They consist of a Request for Entry of Default [Doc. #4], a Request for Writ of Execution/Aid [Doc. #6], a Request that the U.S. Court take Judicial Notice [Doc. #8], a Request for Order of Life Time Injunction & Restraining [Doc. #11], and a Request for Summary Judgment [Doc. #14]. All of these filings are premised on the frivolous claims raised in the Complaint. They should be denied accordingly.

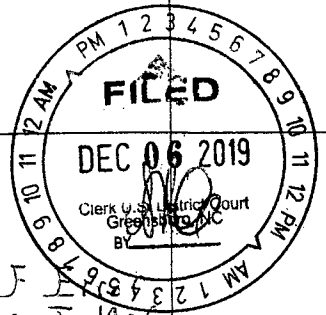

### STATEMENT OF FACTS (See: Pages)

#### POINT

6. The magistrate judge is not subject to this rule because the order did not refer the magistrate judge as master. Under rule 53 of the Fed. R. Civ. P. the master referred is:  
Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas Bey.

7. Having the magistrate Judge involved in this case is non-sense and against the rules, and against my Jurisdiction.

8. The Order of reference in this case is from The Moorish National's - The District Court of The United States.

9. Lets review the Validity of the District Court of The United States hereafter known as The Moorish National Court; Compare Case laws: *mainev. Thiboutot*, 448 U.S. 1; *Mockini V. 3. Status and Jurisdiction," these issues are relevant to the immediate matters of Nationality and Manumissions of the Indigenous Moorish to the Continental Breast of North America. After no jurisdiction over this Moorish American National in his proper person can be claimed and proved by the above challenged Respondents, Et Al; "This Moorish American National should be set free as a citizen in this said Moorish American Nation."
4. Now comes, Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas Bey, a Moorish American National pursuant to the legal documents mentioned above challenge the "Status and Jurisdiction" of the Courts of the State of North Carolina and the Federal Courts of the United States of America; over him as a Moorish American National in his proper person.
5. The "Amistad" case was centered on "Status and Jurisdiction." It was not about slaves but free people of Africa fighting to keep from becoming slaves and retain their freedom.
6. Let's review the infamous "Dred Scott Case" of 1857, which the United States Supreme Court decided, "Negroes could never be citizens of the United States." Except this time let's give old Dred Scott-Bey his true Moorish IDENTITY and, according to Article III Sec. II of the U.S. Constitution.
7. Legally, all so-called Negro, Colored, Black People, were (are) declared labels and names of slaves, as property. These marks were first introduced through the Black Code Laws of 1774 replacing the true Nationality and tribal names of the enslaved Africans.
8. In 1779, Congress ratified these labels and slavery, as an American Institution, lasted until 1865 during the time of lawful slavery (see: The 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Amendments). These labels are encompassed in the "3/5 Clause."
9. Legally, the institution of slavery was abolished by the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment as ratified by Congress, except when imposed upon "duly convicted felons."
10. Nowhere in the Reconstruction Amendments is "Freedom of the Slaves" declared; only the abolishment of the institution of slavery. This is why only two of the original 20 sections of the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment were actually ratified by Congress; the slaves were freed from the southern state plantation owners (1865).
11. Three years later (1868), through the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment, the "Ex-slaves" were "unionized" and became property (subjects) of the jurisdiction of the entire United States, via Wards of the State Courts wherein they reside. (See: Boswell v. Otis, 9 How. 336, 348; to wit) "Property can not be arrested and compelled to appear in court."

MY STATUS MUST BE CORRECTED IN THE EYES OF THE COURT

12. All people, who are free Nationals, are born with the "Inalienable Right" to the inherent nationality of their forefathers, e.g. Chinese, German, Egyptian and Moorish. Any act, lawful or disguised, which deprives a person or people of his birthright, given by their Creator is an

13. The exhuming of a Moorish American National (or Nation) is in dire violation of the U.S. Constitution's Article 1, Section -9 (Clause) and 10 which is "Ex Post Facto" and the courts that enforce these laws are "criminally liable."

14. FACT: All slave names, slave masters and slaves were legally abolished in 1865. The slaves identifying marks of Negro, Colored, Black, etc., which were names given to those enslaved, were also voided with the institution because: These names were applied to captured and imported African Moors were "Demurrable" and an act of "Denationalization" which placed them (me) out of their (my) "Proper Person" to be treated unfairly and unjustly. Hence, Negro, Black, Colored is lawfully 3/5<sup>th</sup> of a person, still!

15. According to Federal Rule Title 18, Section 241-242 "No one has the right, (especially under Cades, and courts, etc.) "To Denationalize, deprive any rights, privileges or immunities by reason of color or race." Whereas the Courts are hereby demanded to prove that Negro, Black, Colored, is a lawful status, with a descendant nature within the scope of nationality or national origin of forefathers, equal to all the other people. Further, prove this status existed before the establishment of the Continental Congress and after its congressional death in 1865. In addition, Negro, Black, Colored is declared "property" and no property can testify against itself in any court of law. Only its owner must appear. Therefore, who owns the Negro, Black, Colored that was declared out in 1865 with the Institution of Slavery? It is the appearance of the Rightful Owner of the Property, not the property, required to answer in a Court of Law. "Courts enforcing mere statutes (statutes?) Do not act judicially but, merely ministerially, thus having no judicial immunity. And, unlike Courts of Law, do not obtain jurisdiction by service of process, nor even arrest and compelled appearance." (See: Boswell v. Otis, 9 How. 336, 348; to wit.)

#### JURISDICTION CHALLENGE

16. Jurisdiction is essentially the authority, conferred by Congress, to decide a given type of case one way or the other. (Hagan v. Lavine). Jurisdiction is always in want of proper parties to be present. See: 28 U.S.C.A. 1251 Et Seq. The Federal Court has the unquestionable authority to entertain suits to redress a person deprived, under color of state law, of constitutional rights.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

(See: Pages)

17. Under the U.S. Supreme Court Ruling, Hagan v. Lavine, jurisdiction cannot be sustained by a lower court, or entertain and decide any claim of conflict between federal and state laws. This ruling also states, as example, that the conflict question is itself a Constitutional Matter within the meaning of U.S.C.A. § 1343(3), proper jurisdiction. The claim of the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment to abolish all entities of slavery (slave names, Slave Masters, slaves e.g. Negro, Black, Colored) now becomes ex post facto in the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment which then declares the same Negro, Black, Colored slaves as "citizens," disguised under the word "Person" and

made subject to the jurisdiction. This claim gives rise to a legal conflict between Slavery and Freedom. And, is in itself then, a Constitutional Issue!!!

16. Hagan v. Lavine further establishes- that a "substantial" question was necessary to support jurisdiction. How the word "Black" can find no formal place within the nationalities of the human family and still can be made "citizen" of any free national and constitutional government/ (Now that is the substantial 'A' question of the age?!!). This is substantial, sound and merited question and the framers of the 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Amendments, those Supreme Court Justices, which decided the Dred Scott case of 1857 and the Phantom Supreme Court case that overturned that decision, only can answer it legally although historically no such overruling precedence was ever recorded in the U.S. Law. Here it must be remembered, only the "proper status" can be heard in the "proper jurisdiction." Being "Black" is not a District or Superior Court issue. In fact the "black label" would leave any Court in want of jurisdiction; except the U.S. Supreme Court a special Congressional Committee and/or the United Nations International Court of Justice, (The World Court), in The Hague, Netherlands.

19. Once the jurisdiction of a court is challenged, it, The Court, must investigate the authenticity of the status in question before it can proceed. The court "In Personam jurisdiction," then must prove it has the power over the personage of the Petitioner (not "quasi in rem"; power over property). Any court, which lacks personal jurisdiction, is also a court without power to issue an "in Personam judgment" (Pennoyer v. Neff 95 U.S. 714, 24 Led. 565). The Petitioner has proclaimed, declared and now reaffirm he is not and can not be a Negro, Black, Colored, etc. "because these names (slave labels) were given to slaves by slave holders in 1779 and lasted until 1865 during the time of slavery" ... (See: Act-6: Divine Constitution of Moorish America and By-Laws). 25. "Your" forefathers wrote and established the above mentioned laws that "we" must Respect and Obey. And, pursuant to their laws, clearly established over a hundred and forty-five years ago "property" cannot be required to be arrested or compelled to appear or testify against itself in a court of law, only its owner must appear. (See: Boswell v. Otis, 9 How. 336, 348; to wit) Also see; Federal Rule Title 18, Section 241-242. No one has the right, especially under Cadges and courts, etc.). (Also: Title 18, Section 1203).

Statement of the Case - Findings per Fed. R. Civ. P. 52(c):

Now this is a Averment of Jurisdiction and Federal-Question Jurisdiction Filed by the M.A.G. seeking damages, injunctive and restraining order relief based on conspiracy and Denationalization and Genocide. In this Request the M.A.G. seeks Summary Judgment on the claim arising from the denial of due Process and Denationalization at Birth.

2. Statement of Facts:

As set forth in the accompanying affirmation Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas Bey was Denationalized at birth and Punished without due Process. The practice of the state of N.C. and the U.S. is to reduce me to Property as a slave. No evidence has been Submitted to confirm my Slave Status. However evidence has been Submitted to refute my Slave Status i.e. Certificate of live birth, Social Security Card, Warrant for Arrest, Prison ID.

3. Argument

Point I

The proper status and correct Jurisdiction was not established in connection with my Punishment. However it was established in the present above captioned Case. I am Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas Bey with the M.A.G., as a Moorish American National, cf: Dred Scott Decision 1857 in Complaint.

A. Failure to establish correct Jurisdiction and proper status denied Due Process. Property cannot be required to be arrested or compelled to appear or testify against itself in a Ct. of law only its owner must appear i.e. U.S. Congress - (State and Federal Ct.s). See BoSwell V. Otis 9 How. 236, 348; to wit.

B. All slave labels-master etc. were abolished by the 13th Amendment as ratified by Congress, except when imposed upon "duly convicted Felons." I was not duly convicted and have challenged the status and Jurisdiction of the U.C. Ct. system. see Edmonds V. U.S., 436 F. Supp. 2d 28 (D.C. 2006); United States V. Singla, 686 Fed. 2d 832, 835 (1981); and Skrizewski V. U.S., 292 F. Supp. 2d 277 (D. N.H. 2003); Adams V. Bain, 697 F. 2d 1213 (4th Cir. 1982).

Point II

4. The United States its Congress and U.S. Supreme Court are Liable for the Conspiracy upon my head. See Fee/Fine in Federal Rule Title 18, Section 241-242.

5. The conspirators in the illegal establishment of laws, under 13th, 14th and 15th Amendments to the Constitution of the United States caused a negative effort and illegal constitutional deprivation of my proper status and Jurisdiction at birth rendering me as a piece of Property; while denationalization was practiced upon me - my head; without my knowledge of Consent.

6. Conclusion: Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1746 (D),

For the foregoing reasons, the Court should Grant total Summary Judgment on liability and all demands to Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas Bey on his Denationalization - due Process claim. ## 2. Judicial Notice and Proclamation

3. To All Elected United States Republic Officials and Public Servants of Federal, State, City, and Municipal Governments, Personnel and Corporate Entities: Concerning the Constitution and all Statutory and Civil Law Codes of the Land, etc., Know All Men by These Presents:

4. Upon my inherited Nobility, and upon my Private Aboriginal / Indigenous, Proper Person Status and Commercial Liability, I, ~~Thomas-Best~~, being duly Affirmed under Consanguine Unity; pledge my National, Political, and Spiritual Allegiance to my Moabite / Moorish Nation - being the archaic Aborigines / Indigenes of Amexem (the Americas); standing squarely affirmed upon my Oath to the 'Five Points of Light' - Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom, and Justice; do squarely Affirm to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth; and having knowledge and firmly - established belief upon the historical, lawful, and adjudicated Facts contained herein. Being competent (In My Own Proper Person) to Attest to this Affidavit upon which I place my Signature; Whereas, I State, Proclaim, and Declare the following to be true, correct, certain, complete, not misleading, supreme, and not intended to be presented for any misrepresented, 'colored' or improper use or purpose, to wit:

5. That I, ~~Thomas-Best~~, Am a Noble of the Al Moroccan Empire (North America) In Propria Persona (my own proper self); being Moorish American - a Descendant of the Ancient Moabites / Moors, by Birthright, Freehold, Primogeniture and Inheritance; being Aboriginal and Indigenous to the Land /s (Amexem / Americas) Territorium of my Ancient Moabite / Moorish Fore-Mothers and Fore-Fathers - to wit:

6. The Al Moroccan (American) Continents - are the Land of the Moors; being North America, South America; Central America; including the adjoining Islands (Americana / Ameru / Al Moroc). I have, acknowledge, claim and possess, by said Inheritance and Primogeniture, the Freehold Status thereto; all Unalienable and Substantive Rights, to Be, to Enjoy, and to Act, distinct in my Aboriginal Customs and Culture; and determining my own political, social, and economic status of the State. Turning my heart and mind back to my Ancient Mothers and Fathers - Moors / Muurs, by Divine and Natural Right. Being Moorish American, we have and possess the internationally recognized Rights to determine our own 'Status of the State' absent of threat, coercion, or acquiescence to a Color-of-Law, a Color-of-Office, nor to be subjected to an imposed Color-of-Authority.

Moors / Moorish Americans / Muurs Have, Proclaim and Possess the Unalienable, Substantive

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Rights and Birthright - Inheritance to our Al Moroccan Names and Nationality by Nature's Laws, Divine Law, Primogeniture, and by the recognized Laws of the Nations of the Earth (International). Being the true, Ancient, Aboriginal / Indigenes of the Land (America) - North, being the heart-land of the Moroccan Empire. Moors / Muurs are the 'De jure' Freeholders by Birthright, Inheritance and Primogeniture Status; and have, Claim and Possess the Secured Rights to Travel upon the Public Roadways, Byways and Highways of our Continental United States (the Organic Land) absent of foreign 'colored' or imposed excise taxation constructs invented, by the racketeering States' Legislators, to abridge and steal Rights belonging to the Natural Peoples. With their Canaanite, Hittite and Amorite brethren who sojourned from the Land of Canaan seeking new homes. Their Dominion and Inhabitation extended from North-East and South-West Africa, across the great Atlantis even unto the present North, South and Central America and also Mexico and the Atlantis Islands; before the great earthquake, which caused the great Atlantic Ocean.

9. **The 'Great Seal Pyramid'** is the 'National Emblem and Insignia' of The Moorish Nation / Empire of North America (geographical location). The Great Pyramid is also the archaic symbol for Civilization on the planet Earth. The honorable Moors' acknowledgement of our 'Great Seal' indicates those Heirs who own up to, who support, and who proclaim, our 'Free National Government'. Moors who are 'Active' and NOT 'Passive' in the Social, Civilization, Culture and Custom matters, involving Law, Order and Governmental Principles, are hereby entreated to support this Affirmation. Moors / Muurs who strive toward this end, with honor, are entrusted by Noble Drew Ali, to help in the great humanitarian work of uplifting ourselves, our fellow-man, and humanity at large. We seek, at all times, to be conscious of the works, instructions, and acts necessary to teach, preserve and defend the Birthrights of All Moorish Americans (Al Moroccans), etc.

9. **The Noble Moors / Muurs (Heirs Apparent)** are the Natural Members / Citizens of the Ancient Al Moroccan Empire (North America) and are duty-bound to recognize and to support our 'Great Seal' Sovereign Moorish Government and Nation of the Natural People, and command the enforcement of our Constitution. Thus, such organized communication Orders are referred to as "The Great Seal National Association of Moorish Affairs". The Free Moorish Nation - inclusive of all the Aboriginal / Indigene Tribes and Provinces of the Natural People, etc., are the rightful bearers of the Names and Titles, Ali, El, Bey, Dey, and Al. The Free Moors / Muurs, by Freehold Inheritance, retain all Substantive Rights and Immunities; enjoy the exercising of Substantive Rights, and operate upon consummated, Right-Law, Isonomi - Principles; having vested Constitution -

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secured Rights and Immunities from TAXATION, and from Criminal and Civil Jurisdiction by, and of, the Union States Rights Republic (U.S.A.), pursuant to, but not limited to, the United States Republic Supreme Court, and the 'Acts of State' to wit:

*"Every Sovereign State (People) is bound to respect the independence of every other Sovereign State (People) and the courts of one country (People) will not sit in judgment on the acts of the government of another, done within (the same or) its own territory..."*

10. The present Union States Municipal and Civil Laws and Codes of the Land are an 'incorporated unit of self-government' established by the political powers of the 'General Assembly' of each State of the Union, and initiated at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, North America, in the year Eighteen fifty-four (1854). It governs 'ONLY' the rights and conduct of "WHITE PEOPLE", Christians and Jews, of the Eighteen sixty-three (1863) Union States Rights Republic, under the Magna Charta (Charter), the Knights of Columbus Code, and the Ku Klux Klan Oath. Furthermore, I Assert My full Birthrights - Sovereignty and Substantive Rights and claim to Hereditaments - Being a Sundry Free Moor / Muur and a (Natural Being) pursuant to: Moabite / Moorish Pedigree; The Free Moorish Zodiac Constitution; The Great Seal of the Moorish Nation (Ab Antiquo); The Treaty of Peace and Friendship - 1787 / 1836; The Sundry Free Moors Act of 1790; The 1781 Organic United States Constitution; The Moorish Federal Financiers Act (Union States Army: 1861 -1863); The 1854 Roman Catholic Magna Charta; the Knights of Columbus Code; The Ku Klux Klan Oath; The United Nations Charter, Article 55(c); The Rights of Indigenous People: Part I, Articles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5; Part II, Article 6; The United States Supreme Court - 'Acts of State'; The foreign Sovereign Immunities Act 28 USC 1601; et Sequa., The Convention on International Road Traffic -Day 19, September 1949, The World Court Decision, The Hague, Netherlands - Day 21, January 1958 A.D = 1378 M.C. In reference to the Rights of the Natural People and Substantive Rights, etc., the following are pertinent Supreme Court Decisions, (Stare Decisis) to wit:

1. The Right to Travel; The Right to Mode of Conveyance; The Right to Locomotion are all Absolute Rights, and the Police can not make void the exercise of Rights. *State v. Armstead*, 60 s. 778, 779, and 781:

2. The use of the highways for the purpose of travel and transportation is not a mere privilege, but a common and Fundamental Right of which the public and Natural Beings cannot be deprived. *Chicago Motor Coach v. Chicago* 337 Illinois 200, 169 NE 22, ALR, *Ligare v. Chicago* 139 ILL. 46, 28 HE 934, *Boone v. Clark* 214 SW 607, 25 AM jur (1st), Highways, sec. 163:

3. The Right to Park or Travel is part of the Liberty of which the Natural Person, citizen cannot be deprived without "due process of law" under the 5th Amendment of the United States Constitution. *Kent v. Dulles* 357 US 116, 125:

4. The Right of a citizen to Travel upon the public highways and to transport one's property thereon, either by carriage or automobile, is not a mere privilege, which a City may prohibit or permit at will, but a common Right, which he / she has under the Right to Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness. *Thompson v. Smith* 154 SE 579:

5. State Police Power extends only to immediate threats to public safety, health, welfare, etc., *Michigan v. Duke* 266 US, 476 Led. At 449: which driving and speeding are not. *California v. Farley* Ced. Rpt. 89, 20 CA3rd 1032 (1971):

6. The state is prohibited from violating Substantive Rights. *Owens v. City*, 445 US 662 (1980); and it can not do by one power (eg. Police Power) that which is, for example, prohibited expressly to any other such power (eg. Taxation / Eminent Domain) as a matter of Law. *US and UT v. Daniels*, 22 p 159, nor indirectly that which is prohibited to it directly. *Fairbanks v. US* 181, US 283, 294, 300:

7. Traveling in an automobile on the public roads was not a threat to the public safety or health and constituted no hazard to the public, and such a traveler owed no other duty to the public (eg. the State); he / she and his / her auto, having equal right to and on the roadways / highways as horses and wagons, etc.; this same right is still Substantive Rule, in that speeding, running stop signs, traveling without license plates, or registration, are not threats to the public safety, and thus, are not arrestable offenses. *Christy v. Elliot*, 216 I 131, 74 HE 1035, LRA NS 1905—1910: *California v.*

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Farley 98 CED Rpt. 89, 20 CA 3d 1032 (1971).

✓ 8. Under the United States Republic's Constitutional system of Government and upon the individuality and intelligence of the citizen, the State does not claim to control one's conduct to others, leaving one the sole judge as to all that affects oneself. **Mugler v. Kansas** 1213 US 623, 659—60:

✓ 9. Where Rights secured by the Constitution are involved, there can be no rule - making or legislation, which would abrogate them. **Miranda v. Arizona** 384 US 436, 125:

✓ 10. The claim and exercise of Constitutional Rights cannot be converted into a crime. **Miller v. Kansas** 230 F 2nd 486, 489:

✓ 11. For a crime to exist, there must be an injured party (Corpus Delicti). There can be no sanction or penalty imposed on one because of this Constitutional Right. **Sherer v. Cullen** 481 F. 945:

✓ 12. If any Tribunal (court) finds absence of proof of jurisdiction over a person and subject matter, the case must be dismissed. **Louisville v. Motley** 211 US 149, 29S. CT 42. "The Accuser Bears the Burden of Proof Beyond a Reasonable Doubt".

✓ 13. "Lack of Federal Jurisdiction can not be waived or overcome by agreement of parties". **Griffin v. Matthews**, 310 F Supra 341, 342 (1969): and "Want of Jurisdiction may not be cured by consent of parties". **Industrial Addition Association v. C.I.R.**, 323 US 310, 313.

12. Whereas, In light of the foregoing Jurisprudence 'Stare Decisis' Supreme Court Decisions, Facts, and Law; and counter to the negative and 'colorable' social conditions instituted by State Persons of the Union States Society, there exists a blatant 'WANT OF JURISDICTION' on the part of the Union States Rights Republic (U.S.A.), its agents, personnel, contractors, and assigns. Axioms are legally in force under National and International Law attending these issues. And this Affiant (Natural Person<sup>✓</sup> In Propria Persona) does not waive any rights; does not transfer power of attorney; and does not willingly consent to any public trial or hearing in any 'colorable' tribunal venue or non-Article III, unconstitutional jurisdiction. The Official Oaths, the Obligations, and the Fiduciary duties of all accusers and bound 'claimants' to National Law and Order; Civilization Principles fixed in Constitution Law, still stands! Definition and Truth still Rules. NON-COMPLIANCE is a Federal and International Law offence.

13. Whereas, there is no question that a 'Bench Appearance Summons', Detention, Arrest and Ticket or Citation issued by a Police Officer or others for traveling with no driver's license, foreign driver's license, not having current registration, or mandatory insurance, etc., which carries a fine or jail time, is a penalty or sanction and is indeed "converting a right into a crime"; thus violating Substantive Rights. It is reasonable to assume that these Supreme Court judicial decisions are straight and to the point, that there is no lawful method for government to put restrictions or limitations on Rights belonging to the People.

14. That the Organic United States Republic Constitution (derived from Ancient Moabite / Moorish Law) remains 'The Supreme Law of the Land'. And all Treaties made, or which shall be made, under the Authority of The United States Flag of Peace, pursuant to United States Code, Title 4, Chapter 1. Any law that is Repugnant to the Constitution, shall remain forever 'colorable' and is Null and Void.

15. CONCLUSION:  
For the foregoing reasons, the Court should grant the request in its entirety.
