MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner JOSE CANDELARIO PEREZ-CRUZ by and through appointed CJA counsel, Supreme Court Rule 39.1, and 18 U.S.C. §3006A(d)(6), asks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. In support thereof it is submitted:

1. Petitioner has **not** previously been granted leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in any other court.
2. Petitioner's affidavit or declaration is **not** attached because the court below appointed counsel in the current proceeding, and:
3. The appointment was made under the Criminal Justice Act.

4. Section 3006A(d)(6) of Title 18, United States Code, provides as follows:

(6) Proceedings before appellate courts.-

“If a person for whom counsel is appointed under this section appeals to an appellate court or petitions for a writ of certiorari, he may do so without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefore and without filing the affidavit required by section 1915(a) of title 28.”


