
*Petitioner.*

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Petitioner, pro se, has filed a petition for a writ of mandamus directing Connecticut officials to cease alleged discriminatory activities. Petitioner also moves for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and for appointment of pro bono counsel. Pamela Eisenlohr, pro se, moves to intervene. Upon due consideration, it is hereby ORDERED that the motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis is GRANTED for the purpose of filing the mandamus petition. The mandamus petition is DENIED, as “[t]he federal courts have no general power to compel action by state officials.” *Davis v. Lansing*, 851 F.2d 72, 74 (2d Cir. 1988); *see also* 28 U.S.C § 1651. All other motions are DENIED as moot.
