MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioners Dendrick Demond Hall, David Andrew Hunt, and Lusion Yoshua Rice respectfully move for leave to file the attached petition for writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis* in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 39 and 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(7).
