**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS**


The petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

There is a lot missing in between the dates. This is just to give you an idea how much my husband spent on groceries.

- Clothing: School uniforms and school essentials \$161.37
- Laundry and dry cleaning: \$40.00 monthly with water haul, fuel, vehicle insurances & yearly tags, water trailer tires repairs and tire replacements at times with laundry soap/ dryer sheets.
- Medical and dental expenses: We don't have no medical nor dental insurance as of now. Travel about 150 miles to IHS for medical needs.
- Western Arizona Regional Medical Center: 2,580.00 adjusted cost. We pay 860.00 a month until paid off. My husband end up in the emergency room with no insurance.
- Bullhead City Fire Department: First responders to my husbands emergency 1223.41. We have not started paying on this. But we need to start making payments here very soon. Trying to juggled bills so we have a little bit for fuel to get to work. I am thinking maybe 25.00 maybe every time we get paid to start paying, until the Western Arizona Regional Medical Center gets paid off.
- Radiology Associates of Northwest Az, PLC: 1554.00 We not started payment on this too. My plan is to start payment at 25.00 until Western Arizona Regional Medical Center is paid off. Then we will increase payments.
- Transportation for our son, from school to house twice a week: 100.00 a month for fuel. Luckily I have a friend in town where my son goes to school which is about 18 miles away from the house. We traded to haul woods for him this year for the winter. Him and his wife agreed to bring my son home from school when I can't pick him up at the bus stop, because I work from noon to 10pm at night. My husband comes home later around about 5pm and stays home with our son in the evenings while I am at work. This is the only way we can keep up with the bills and the necessities of our home. I was very sick for along time and could not hold down a job for not even a year.

I would work and quit and recover and then try working again. I was diagnose with seizures and epilepsy about 2 years ago and have been on treatment for year now. I think I am recovering from my illness, so now I am working again.
