The Department of State inquired into the status of the relevant legal proceedings and has been informed that there is no date set for execution of Mr. Ashkanpanah. Mr. Ashkanpanah's appeal is now pending before the California Supreme Court, with additional briefs to be filed before any decision on appeal. Given the status of the case, counsel for Mr. Ashkanpanah has the opportunity to pursue appropriate and timely legal objections to his conviction or incarceration. Any right Mr. Ashkanpanah may have to a new trial is a judicial determination for the competent court.

When asked way he told retired Jusge Charles Frisco, prior to his 1997 enrobing ceremony, that he had served in Viemam and was awarded a Purple Heart Couwenberg offored this straised explanation: "I didn't affirm it, but 1 didn' cecrect him," he said. "I thought it was basically a 'roast' as he had done belore - a humorous thing."
Two groups - the governor's office and the State Bar's Commission on Jadicial Nominees Evaluation - are
respansible for checking jucticial candidates' credentiak, After the disciplinary charges zgainst Couwenberg were filed. both offices acknowiedged that neither academic nor military backgrounds are veriffed.
