



Therefore, this writ request to Proceed In Forma Pauperis should be granted in accord with substantive right to due process of law per the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the National Constitution 1791, and, have been granted previously in the district court in **Case No. 1:17-CV-00189**, and, in accord with *Steffler v. United States, 319 U.S. 38 (1943)* “*A poor person entitled to prosecute an appeal from the District Court to the Circuit Court of Appeals is authorized by the *in forma pauperis* statute to apply to the District Court for leave to appeal in forma pauperis, and it is the duty of the District Court*


