UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO FILE BRIEF OF RESPONDENT

The Respondent, State of Mississippi, respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days within which to file the Brief of the Respondent in the above styled and numbered cause, thus making it due on May 20, 2020, response is presently due on April 20, 2020. Counsel has and has had additional commitments which have prevented the timely filing of the State's Brief in Opposition.

Counsel continues the preparation of supplemental discovery responses for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi case of *Jordan et al v. Fisher et al.*, No. 3:15-CV-00295-HTW-LRA, which were originally due on March 31, 2020, but for which additional time has been jointly requested but not yet ruled upon. Additionally, counsel is preparing a response to a petition for post-conviction relief filed by capital litigant Justin Underwood in the Mississippi Supreme Court in the case of *Underwood v. State*, No. 2015-DR-01378-SCT, which is due on June 1, 2020. This request is not made to cause undue delay and counsel for Petitioner has no objection to this requested extension.
