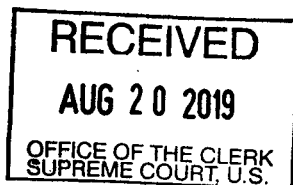

MOTION FOR JUSTICE BRETT M. KAVANAUGH FOR AN EXTENTION OF
TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI DUE TO EXIGENT
CIRCUMSTANCES

Defendant – Appellant Ronald Muhammad, hereby moves for an extension time of 60 days to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari due to exigent circumstances. The Booklet Format per Rule 33 was impossible per Rule 39.3. In support of his motion, Ronald Muhammad states as follows:
