MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED  
INFORMA PAUPERIS

COMES NOW Petitioner, Marlon Miller, and pursuant to Rule 39, Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, moves this Court for an Order granting him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

- 1) Petitioner was determined indigent by the district court, pursuant to Title 18 U.S.C. §3006A, and counsel was appointed to represent him on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.
