MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

1. On September 18, 2019, the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit denied Petitioner's Motion for Rehearing En Banc and Petition For Rehearing. Turner v. Kemna, Case No.19-1320.


and is vacant. Petitioner had been transferred to Western Missouri Correctional Center and this Order was not forwarded to him.
