ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 23, 2019, the Court denied Plaintiff leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 in this action because he is subject to the filing restriction in § 1915(g). The Court also ordered Plaintiff to pay the full amount of \$400.00 (\$350.00 filing fee, plus a \$50.00 administrative fee) if he wishes to pursue his claims in this action. On January 10, 2020, Plaintiff's appeal from the order denying him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* was dismissed. In a Minute Order (ECF No. 20) entered on January 13, 2020, Plaintiff was directed to pay the full amount of \$400.00 on

or before February 3, 2020. Plaintiff was warned that the action would be dismissed without further notice if he failed to pay the full amount of \$400.00 within the time allowed.

Plaintiff has failed within the time allowed to pay the filing and administrative fees as directed. Therefore, the action will be dismissed. Furthermore, the Court certifies pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3) that any appeal from this order would not be taken in good faith and therefore *in forma pauperis* status will be denied for the purpose of appeal. See *Coppedge v. United States*, 369 U.S. 438 (1962). In addition, because Plaintiff is subject to the filing restriction in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), he must pay the full \$505 appellate filing fee if he files a notice of appeal. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Prisoner Complaint (ECF No. 1) and the action are dismissed without prejudice pursuant to Rule 41(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure because Plaintiff failed to pay the required filing and administrative fees as directed. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal is denied.
