**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED
IN FORMA PAUPERIS**

TO THE HONORABLE JUSTICES OF SAID COURT:

COMES NOW the Petitioner, JORGE MACLI, by and through his undersigned counsel and hereby moves this Honorable Court to allow him to proceed in forma pauperis, pursuant to Rule 39, Supreme Court Rules, and pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C.
