

ORDER


We have read and considered the petition for writ of habeas corpus filed on November 4, 2019.

The petition is procedurally barred as untimely and successive. (*In re Reno* (2012) 55 Cal.4th 428, 459-463; *In re Robbins* (1998) 18 Cal.4th. 770, 779-780; *In re Clark* (1993) 5 Cal.4th 750, 764-765, 767-768.) Also, petitioner's claims could and should have been raised in his direct appeal. (*In re Harris* (1993) 5 Cal.4th 813, 825-826; *In re Dixon* (1953) 41 Cal.2d 755, 759.) But even assuming petitioner's claims are not procedurally barred, petitioner has failed to demonstrate a *prima facie* case for habeas relief.

Accordingly, the petition is denied.
