I hired Attorney Gianni Sam Stephano for Workers Compensation fees for on the job injuries, while I was on tour of duty has a uniformed C/O Officer at California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, CSP-Sacramento; starting with an assault upon a uniformed officer (Audrey J. Ukkerd) by a male, white, uniformed Correctional Supervisor Sergeant. Also, Attorney Stephano was hired to get Workers Compensation on the job related injuries to body; back, brain, buttock, neck, arm, wrist, hips, stress, anxiety, and Post Traumatic Stress Syndrome. No QME for body parts were requested by Attorney Stephano.

The State Bar of California states that, According to your Workers Compensation summaries online, the case was settled with the compromise and release filed and closing order signed off by the Judge in the matter on June 20, 2019. You were not happy with the settlement and filed this complaint. Mr. Siegel is the attorney of the Law firm you hired. He would be responsible for the conduct of his subordinate, Mr. Stephano.

I (Audrey J. Ukkerd) was not happy because Attorney Stephano encouraged me to sign documents without counseling concerning the repercussions that I was releasing my Kaiser Permanente Health Services. Attorney Stephano never mentioned anything about an Order Approving Compromised and Release Papers.

The QME Agreed upon Attorney Doctor filed an "Adjustment to Injury Questionnaire this was to complete the initial incomplete Examination QME Agreed upon Attorney Evaluation was invalid Dated March 25, 2017. In September 2017, Attorney Stephano requested that, "He would send a Declaration of Readiness Emergency Mandatory Settlement and get back with me in two weeks. Attorney Stephano did not get back with me in two weeks. Attorney Stephano abandoned the case for 6 or 7 months non responsive to my Emails and iPhone calls. No letters. No Updates.

I filed the first DOR Mandatory Settlement December 19, 2018 and Attorney Stephano was seen by me and Husband at the Mandatory Settlement Conference. My Husband and I were not invited into the conference room. No paralegals were mentioned in notice.

Attorney Stephano Emailed that he sent Email regarding DOR Mandatory Settlement Conference confirmation date 04/17/2019. I discovered Email regarding WCAB Declaration of Readiness (DOR) MSC was dated 11/01/2011 and not 04/17/2019 Attorney Stephano's Emails were not sent and filed on 4/17/2019. No Notice of Status Conference Hearing correspondence neither mailed to my home to this date June 20, 2019: nor did I receive per Postal Mail. Attorney Stephano engaged in untruths conduct involving unethical behavior suggesting fraud, perjury, negligence, attorney misconduct, and attorney malpractice.

I filed a second Declaration of Readiness Mandatory Settlement Conference and I received a Hearing Notice regarding Status Conference June 20, 2019 WCAB appointment time 1:30 PM, 160 Promenade 300, Sacramento, CA. 95834. Attorney Stephano was the only person that talked to me and my husband in the waiting room of WCAB Building. The Judge Gregory Cleveland, Workers' Compensation Administrative Law Judge, and the Workers Comp. Appeals Board Members were not present and/or seen by me or by my husband. Attorney Stephano engaged in conduct that is prejudicial to the administration of justice: knowingly assisted in conduct that is a violation of applicable rules of judicial conduct and compromised my case. The Hearing Notice did not invite a paralegal to the Status Conference. *Notice to attorneys: You may be able to appear at this conference by phone no paralegals mentioned in Hearing Notice Dated 06/20/2019.

The State Bar of California states that, "You stated that on January 1, 2010, you hired G. Sam Stephano of Michael J. Siegle Law Firm to represent you in Workers' Compensation matter. Mr. Stephano is a Hearing Representative and not an attorney. The case got dragged out for years. Your ex-employer denied the claim. Mr. Stephano told you that you had to go to Trial and win in order to get temporary disability. The opposing side offered \$25,000 to settle without going to Trial. Mr. Stephano told you to take the deal, because if you lose, you get nothing. You went to the last hearing on June 20, 2019, in which Mr. Stephano told you to sign the settlement papers"

Michael Siegel Esq. is not the attorney of the Law Firm when I hired G. Sam Stephano on or around, January 01, 2010 at Penney's & Associates Law Office, Roseville.

After completing an On-Line Application Questionnaire computer Website for an Attorney; Penny and & Associates Law Office, Roseville; Attorney Gianni Sam Stephano responded to my Workers Compensation Cumulative Trauma Case via Phone Call.

History: The month of January 01, 2010, Attorney Stephano worked at Penney & Associates Legal Law Firm, 2999 Douglas Blvd., Lobby, Roseville, CA., (707) 438-8000; and the month of February year of 2010 to 2015 Stephano worked for Penny & Associates Legal Law Firm 6536 Lone Tree Blvd., Rocklin, CA. 95765, (916) 786-7662; (2015 & 2016) and lastly Attorney Stephano worked with Michael Siegel, Esq. Law Office 6060 Sunrise Vista Drive, suite 2280, Citrus Heights, CA. 95610, (916) 546-1431 ext. 101, (2016 to present); Paralegals and Legal Assistants for Attorney Stephano: Michaela Gallo, and Megan McGrath during the nine years and six months. Note: Hypothetical; Allegedly Michaela Gallo and Megan McGrath are Attorneys and are out of The State of California jurisdiction practicing Legal Law,

Attorney Stephano instructed me to initial A U on paper and there were no other signatures seen by me (Audrey J. Ukkerd) written on the paper at the Status Conference Hearing Dated 06/20/2019. I was asked by Attorney Stephano to initial A U next to the body parts such as Eyes, Ears, Mouth, Back, Brain, neck, wrist, etc.

After: I reviewed the Settlement papers dated 06/20/2019 I discovered that my initials A U were on the left side of the paper and on the right side of my initials were the initials of the Defendant K H with a new list other than body parts named. I was not instructed to sign my initials on a DWC-CA form 10214 © (Rev. 11/2008) (Page 7 of 9), I did not sign the legal form WCMSA CSP-Sacramento; ADJ7395654, Claim no. 05554964 pages.

There was No legal title on the top or bottom of the paper that Attorney Stephano instructed me to initial A U. I had no knowledge of a Compromised and Release Legal Document until I reviewed the Settlement papers. I did not sign the legal papers displaying Attorney Stephano signature, dated 06/17/2019) three days before the Status Conference Hearing Notice Dated 06/20/2019. In addition Attorney G. Sam Stephano told The State Bar of California Office Chief Trial Counsel Deputy Peter Eng that he was not an Attorney.

The Legal Adviser comments on computer website crashes every time he attempted to bring it up and that it no longer exists. It appears that the website Attorney Stephano represents an imposter or he is an out of State Attorney who is not who he says he is?

Practicing Legal Attorney Peter Brixie confirmation that Attorney Gianni Sam Stephano is an Attorney and Website confirmation by my Husband retired California Highway Patrolman located Attorney Sam Stephano on his iPhone computer Website Stephano is an Attorney/ 2015.

The Status Conference Hearing Dated 06/20/2019 took place in an empty waiting room: WCAB Building 160 Promenade Circle, 300, Sacramento, CA 95834. There was No Judge seen by me; neither were there any WCAB Members present to be seen by me. Attorney Stephano walked back and forth in and out of a room located near the waiting room. In conclusion a man and woman appeared and sat near me and my Husband. Attorney Stephano used them for witnesses of my signature. Regarding Order Approving Compromised and Release Legal Document I did not place a Black Check Mark regarding (No Appeals). Settlement papers displayed two witnesses with different Sir (last) names.

Prior conversation a few weeks before the Status Conference Hearing Dated June 20, 2019, Attorney Stephano mentioned to me that, "He didn't like what I said about Defendants the CDCR; CSP-Sacramento Warden J W at CSP-Sac in a prior Lawsuit against the California Department of Corrections Rehabilitation Discrimination Case. Attorney Stephano's conversation suggested grounds for retaliation.

The evidence shows that Attorney Stephano committed a fraudulent act by falsifying and misrepresenting himself which is deemed unethical behavior and a violation of the Law suggesting Negligence, Malpractice, Attorney Misconduct, Conspiracy, Perverted Evidence, Sabotage, Injustice. I was denied my Civil Tort Rights, Civil Rights, Criminal Law, SCIF Workers' Compensation CT, and the 6th and the 9th Constitutional Rights.

I was never interviewed by my Ex-employer CDCR CSP-Sacramento. I notified the Central services CDCR-CSP-Sacramento Chain of Command and documented the occurrence. One year later, the issue has not been resolved or investigated. My safety and security concerns were ignored or rejected by the CDCR CSP-Sac Administration.

There are No Ex- employer CDCR CSP-Sacramento incident reports Dated January 16, 2009 and for December 19, 2009 for an investigation of an assault on a Black female Correctional Officer by a male white Supervisor Sergeant. Ex-employer failed to communicate with the victim of circumstances (Audrey J. Ukkerd).

On December 19, 2018, at the Mandatory Settlement Conference Hearing Attorney Stephano stated to me and my Husband, "I was going to be happy this year. Therefore, and under duress I signed the OTOC Stephano's rational was, that all parties were not served Mandatory Settlement Conference papers and needed time to prepare for the case. Attorney Stephano stated, Doctor Lieberman ranked you 60 per cent disability, and they want to take care of you! The Adjuster is here and she is on your side. She said, "That this case should have been settled two years ago and that she was assigned to another case: but they gave it back to her. Attorney Stephano said, Judge Gregory Cleveland, Workers' Compensation Administrative Law Judge, was in agreement with the Adjuster." My Husband's response was oh she is? Attorney Stephano's response was "yes." My Husband asked Attorney Stephano is there any Time limitation to this case and Attorney Stephano's response was, "NO", and then he turned and walked back to the conference room. Attorney Stephano promised that it would only be two weeks before he would file another DOR MSC: but it didn't happen. Nothing was done by Attorney Stephano regarding concern to file a Declaration of Readiness Mandatory Settlement

Hypothetically, the OTOC (Order to Take off Calendar) signature was transferred to the Settlement Papers Order Approving Compromised and Release Papers by the Attorney his/her who is out of the State of California Jurisdiction. The Attorney who his/her has no State of California Bar Number attached to his/her name on 06/17/2019 three days before the Status Conference Hearing Dated 06/20/2019 willfully and with malice under the umbrella of the State of California Laws and Administration of Justice for All; transferred (Audrey J. Ukkerd) signature from the OTOC Dated 12/19/2018 to the Settlement Order Approving Compromised and Release Papers.

I did everything that Attorney Gianni Sam Stephano asked me to do for nine years and six months. I'm requesting the California Supreme Court grant me with a fair and honest Administration of Justice Mandatory Settlement in my favor for SCIF Workers' Compensation Cumulative Trauma Case injustice and damages procured by Attorney Gianni Sam Stephano and his employers Attorney Michael J. 





COMPROMISE AND RELEASE
ADDENDUM TO PARAGRAPH 9

Parties agree that this addendum is a material part of this settlement agreement.

Applicant claims to have sustained injury to 110 brain, 130 bilateral eyes, 140 face, 144 mouth, 200 neck, 319 bilateral arms, 330 bilateral hands, 420 back, 841 nervous system - stress and 842 psyche on a cumulative basis from 8/17/1978 until 12/19/2009. No medical evidence exists to support applicant's claims for physical injury. There is a good faith dispute over whether applicant's psych claim is compensable based on reports of AME Dr. Richard Lieberman reports dated 6/8/17, 7/18/2017 and 12/19/17.

At this time the parties wish to buy their peace and avoid the risks and expense of further discovery and litigation. After negotiation, applicant agrees to accept and defendant agrees to pay \$25,000 [twenty five thousand dollars] in full and final settlement of their respective claims and obligations in this matter.


This claim is and at all times has been denied. Because of applicant's age and actual beneficiary status, it was necessary to obtain a Medicare set aside to protect Medicare's interest in the settlement and applicant's interest in her Medicare benefits. A MSA dated 6/10/19 indicates that \$767.28 will be required for psychotherapy over the course of applicant's lifetime. Parties agree that the current settlement agreement also resolves defendant's obligations to fund medical treatment, if any, and the sum of \$767.28 is included in the current amount of the C/R. If any expenses arise for psychotherapy in the future, they are applicant's obligation and not defendant's.

This settlement amount includes interest and penalties if any if paid within 30 days of board approval of this agreement.



The State Bar's Office of Chief Trial Counsel has reviewed your complaint against Michael J. Siegel to determine whether there are sufficient grounds to prosecute a possible violation of the State Bar Act and/or Rules of Professional Conduct.

You stated that on January 1, 2010, you hired G. Sam Stephano of Michael J. Siegel's law firm to represent you in a workers' compensation matter. Mr. Stephano is a hearing representative and not an attorney. The case got dragged out for years. Your ex-employer denied the claim. Mr. Stephano told you that you had to go to trial and win in order to get temporary disability. The opposing side offered you \$25,000 to settle without going to trial. Mr. Stephano told you to take the deal, because if you lose, you get nothing. You went to the last hearing on June 20, 2019, in which Mr. Stephano told you to sign the settlement papers.

According to your workers' compensation summaries online, the case was settled with the compromise and release filed and closing order signed off by the judge in the matter on June 20, 2019. You were not happy with the settlement and filed this complaint. Mr. Siegel is the attorney of the law firm you hired. He would be responsible for the conduct of his subordinate, Mr. Stephano.

Based on our evaluation of the information provided, we are closing your complaint. Under the laws of California, the facts as you have alleged them would not be grounds for disciplinary action. Your workers' compensation claim was initially denied by your ex-employer. However, Mr. Stephano was able to negotiate for a settlement for you in a disputed claim. Even the

medical report written by Dr. Janak Mehtani stated that there was considerable discrepancy in the report of the investigation suggesting that the events at your workplace were not significant enough to establish a sufficient workers' compensation claim. You decided to settle the matter by compromise and release on June 20, 2019.

Regarding your complaint that Mr. Stephano has failed to properly represent you in obtaining a sufficient settlement for you, including future medical, this would be a negligence issue. Before the imposition of attorney discipline can be obtained, the State Bar must present clear and convincing evidence of willful misconduct. Willful misconduct does not include mere negligence or poor judgment by an attorney. The issue you raised is mostly malpractice or negligence issue, which by law, is not a proper basis for discipline. You may also wish to consult with legal counsel regarding any remedies that may be appropriate and available in your situation, including filing to reopen your workers' compensation claim, if appropriate.

For these reasons, the State Bar is closing this matter.

If you have new facts and circumstances that you believe may change our determination to close your complaint, you may submit a written statement with the new information to the Intake Unit for review. If you have any questions about this process, you may call me at 213-765-1323. If you leave a voice message, be sure to clearly identify the lawyer complained of, the inquiry number assigned, and your telephone number including the area code. Your call should be returned within two business days.

If you are not aware of new facts or circumstances but otherwise disagree with the decision to close your complaint, you may submit a request for review by the State Bar's Complaint Review Unit, which will review your complaint and the Intake Unit's decision to close the complaint. The Complaint Review Unit received your correspondence on September 19, 2019, requesting reconsideration of the decision to close your complaint. An attorney reviewed all the information provided and has determined that there is not a sufficient basis to recommend reopening your complaint.

The Complaint Review Unit will recommend reopening a complaint when there is significant new evidence or when we determine there is good cause to recommend that the matter be reopened. The State Bar Court is authorized to impose or recommend disciplinary sanctions only if there is clear and convincing evidence to establish that the attorney has committed a violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct or the State Bar Act. Therefore, the Complaint Review Unit will not recommend that a matter be reopened unless there is a reasonable possibility that a disciplinary violation can be proven by clear and convincing evidence.

In your complaint, you assert that you hired G. Sam Stephano on or around January 1, 2010, to represent you in a workers' compensation matter. You allege that Mr. Stephano was affiliated with the law offices of Penney & Associates when you initially hired him and began working with the Law Offices of Michael Siegel sometime in 2016. You contend that Mr. Stephano misrepresented his status as an attorney to you, asserting he was a member of the State Bar even though he was a hearing representative and not an attorney. You further assert that your case dragged on for years and, after your former employer denied your claim, Mr. Stephano forced you to settle the case without going to trial by informing you that, if you lost at trial, you would get nothing. You allege that Mr. Stephano forced you to sign the settlement papers on June 20, 2019, and that he negligently handled your case.

Your complaint was closed by the Office of Chief Trial Counsel ("OCTC") because the facts you alleged did not establish grounds for disciplinary action. Specifically, as OCTC explained in its

letter closing your complaint, there was insufficient evidence to establish that Mr. Stephano misrepresented his status as an attorney to you because his position as a hearing representative appeared to be disclosed in various documents filed in your workers' compensation matter. As to your claim that Mr. Stephano was negligent in the handling of your case and failed to obtain a sufficient settlement for you, there was insufficient evidence to establish that you ever complained to Mr. Siegel, Mr. Stephano's supervising attorney, about Mr. Stephano's conduct. Furthermore, to the extent you believed that Mr. Stephano and Mr. Siegel failed to adequately perform in their representation of you, those allegations involved potential negligence liability. Because the State Bar only prosecutes willful violations of the duty of competence, your allegations that Mr. Stephano and Mr. Siegel performed incompetently at most constituted negligence, your complaint did not provide a basis for disciplinary action. For all of these reasons, OCTC determined it was necessary to close your complaint.

You request review of the decision to close your complaint. In your request for review, you again assert that Mr. Stephano was negligent in the handling of your workers' compensation matter because the limitation period for a cumulative trauma case is ten years. You also again allege that the settlement in your case was fraudulent and unfair and that you agreed to it only because of mental and physical health issues. You contend that Mr. Stephano's misrepresentations regarding his status as an attorney are evidenced by the fact that he signed the line labeled "Applicant's Attorney" in several documents submitted in your case, in including your settlement agreement. You ask that the State Bar intervene to reopen your workers' compensation matter and rescind your compromise and release because of Mr. Stephano's alleged fraud.

Your request for review does not establish good cause to recommend that this matter be reopened. Please understand that, because Mr. Stephano is not a licensed attorney, the State does not have jurisdiction to take disciplinary action against him for his alleged behavior in your case. The State Bar only has jurisdiction to discipline Mr. Stephano's supervising attorney, Mr. Siegel. Because you have advanced no facts establishing that you alerted Mr. Siegel regarding your concerns about Mr. Stephano's alleged performance, the State Bar does not have a basis upon which to pursue disciplinary charges against Mr. Siegel for his alleged failure to adequately supervise Mr. Stephano's work.

There are also insufficient facts to establish that Mr. Siegel aided and abetted Mr. Stephano's unauthorized practice of law. Under California law, a non-attorney certified hearing representative is entitled to appear on behalf of clients before the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board provided he or she is supervised by an attorney. A non-attorney hearing representative is also allowed to sign documents, including a compromise and release, provided that the supervising attorney has provided written authorization for the hearing representative to do so. The fact that Mr. Stephano signed your Compromise and Release in the line for "Applicant's Attorney" thus does not alone provide a basis upon which to pursue disciplinary action against Mr. Siegel. Because your complaint and request for review fail to advance a

viable basis upon which to pursue disciplinary action against Mr. Siegel, the only individual involved in your case over whom the State Bar has jurisdiction, we have determined your complaint was properly closed.

If you disagree with this decision, you may file an accusation against the attorney with the California Supreme Court. A copy of the applicable rule is enclosed. (See Rule 9.13, subsections (d) through (f), California Rules of Court.) If you choose to file an accusation, you must do so within 60 days of the date of the mailing of this letter. Together with your accusation, you should provide the Supreme Court (1) a copy of this letter and (2) a copy of the original closing letter from the Office of Chief Trial Counsel.
