I am writing to request a sixty-day enlargement of the deadline by which Respondents must respond to the Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Respondent Associated Faculties of the University of Maine; and Respondent University of Maine at Machias, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System do not object to this Request.

The State of Maine (as well as the other Respondents) initially waived their right to respond to the Petition. On February 27, 2020, the Court requested a response to the Petition by March 30, 2020. Due to the press of other business, undersigned counsel requested, and was granted, an enlargement of time to prepare a response to the Petition until April 30, 2020.

On March 15, 2020, the Governor of Maine declared a state of civil emergency in the State of Maine due to COVID-19. Since early March my time has been almost entirely devoted to addressing issues related to the extreme emergency in the State of Maine.
