

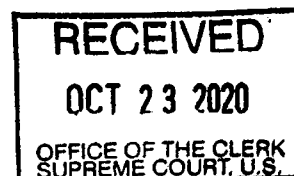


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QUESTIONS PRESENTED

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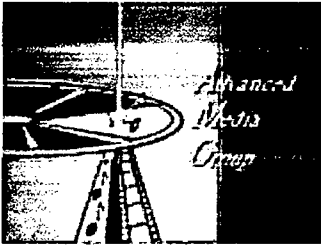

STAN J. CATERBONE DOCUMENTARY re Tulsi Gabbard introduces bills to drop charges against Edward Snowden and Julian Assange and The ISC Story Saturday October 10, 2020

Every single one of us as Americans are guaranteed basic fundamental rights and freedoms that are enshrined in our Constitution. But we cannot take these freedoms for granted. I've introduced legislation to stand up for and to protect brave whistleblowers who've come forward to expose illegal actions within our own government, or egregious abuses of power, and to reform the Espionage Act to make sure that if a whistleblower is prosecuted under the Espionage Act, that they will have their fair day in court, something that is currently not allowable under the law as it stands today. So first, I introduced hrs 1162 with my colleague, Congressman Matt gates, the very simply calls on our government to drop all charges against Edward Snowden for the actions that he took in the public interest to expose a mass government surveillance program on all Americans that violates our privacy and civil liberties, and that courts deemed illegal more than once. I also introduced a trez 1175 with my colleague, Congressman Tom Massie, which calls for the same action for the government to drop all charges against Julian Assange, who also acted in the public interest as he published information to expose lies, and egregious abuses of power in our own government. Last but not least, I introduced a bill, hr 8452. to reform the Espionage Act. A daniel ellsberg was the first person prosecuted under the 1917 Espionage Act for his act of bravery in releasing the pentagon papers to The Washington Post, to publish classified documents that expose the lies. They're being told to the American people about what was really happening in the Vietnam War. Now, Snowden, Assange and others are being prosecuted under this same Espionage Act. But as Daniel Ellsberg knows, well, under current law, none of them are allowed to speak to the intent of their actions in court. My bill changes that. I'm urging my colleagues in Congress to stand up for the American people to stand up for our freedoms, and pass this critical legislation now

compounded since the realization that he's in circumstances, where he will inevitably not be able to see us and where he may himself die as a result of increased risk to COVID-19.

Every Lifeline that we have had in terms of my being able to support him, have been shut down,

I cannot elect to refrain from making this statement, if it might assist the court in understanding that the circumstances in which Julian might be granted bail are wholly different from the circumstances of his life, and indeed mine some eight years ago.

Julius Caesar in Belmarsh prison. Let's be clear what Belmarsh is it's a high security prison, and the regime is brutal. It is absolutely brutal. In the last three months in Belmarsh, there's been two suicides, and one murder. Julian himself locked up for 20 hours a day. And then when he meets his legal team, they take those hours off his normal what they call Association, so his free time when he can be out of the cell is applied, for example, to go to the gym, like other prisoners, and for weeks, he's not been allowed to and he still hasn't been allowed to either. It's the sort of regime that can push you to the edge, it's obviously had the effect on him. There's no doubt about that issues, all sorts of strategies to make sure that he keeps as well as he possibly can. Obviously, he concentrates and focuses on preparing his case for the court. After two hours, I left that prison more convinced than ever before that this man First of all, is innocent of the charges that have been brought against him. Secondly, that actually morally, you've made the right decision. What Julian Assange and his colleagues did was to take the information that they were provided with

And then moral judgment was that these are war crimes being perpetrated here in our name, and that they wanted the world to know, they performed the service for society globally, not just within our own country, he must be extradited to the United States of America as I don't believe he'll get a fair trial a fair hearing. And the risk, therefore is he could spend the rest of his life in prison. Here we have the potential UK Government rolling over to extradite someone. But at the same time, the US government are refusing to extradite someone who we know is associated with an act that resulted in the loss of life. They're done family, and needs proper investigation. And yes, if necessary, court action, the one thing you don't extradite people for, is on political grounds. And that's what's happening with Julian Assange. But they want to send out a message to others, any other journalists, any other publishers, this is what will happen to them as well, if they dare to speak truth to power in the way that Julian Assange has. In any democracy. One of the key ingredients is to have a free and active media. And sometimes the media will annoy us, they'll tell us as politicians things we don't want to hear, or they'll expose things that we didn't want expose it. But that's what democracy is all about. And as soon as you undermine that right of journalists, to report fairly and openly, when you start undermining the basis of democracy on which we, we rest our society, information is coming out now, which demonstrates the extent to which the US government in particular will go to try and silence him, including the rest of his life. The media has not been kind to Julian Assange, in terms of the accurate and honest reporting of his case, what we need now above all else is noise noise about this case, in every form that we can understand this isn't about an individual. This is about the right to free speech, the right to whistle blow the right to stand up against injustice. And if Assange is a silenced, they can silence anyone, and they will. Please don't underestimate the importance of this case for the future of our democracy.



The Court today entered the following order in the above-entitled case:

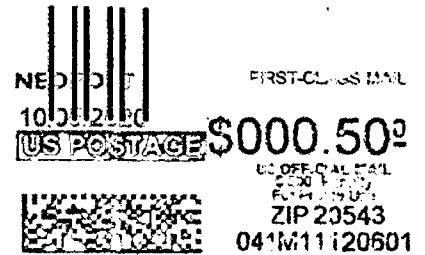
