

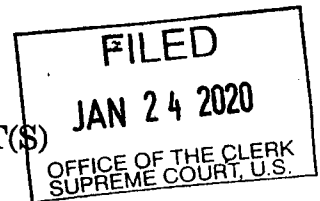

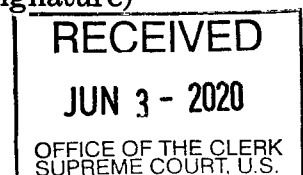

**AFFIDAVIT OR DECLARATION
