I, on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, Florida ("City"), represent Respondents, Officers R.A. Bias, et al., with regard to the above referenced matter. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the in above entitled case was filed on January 10, 2020, and Respondents filed a Waiver of their right to respond on January 21, 2020. However, the Court requested a Response to be filed on or before March 2, 2020. Respondents received an extension of time and the Response is currently due on April 2, 2020.

However, due to the COVID-19 outbreak here in Duval County, Florida and nationwide, government operations have been severely disrupted and we believe extraordinary circumstances exist that necessitate a brief second extension of time as stated in the Supreme Court's March 19, 2020 Order. Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the United State Supreme Court, the City requests a thirty (30) day extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, up to and including **May 4, 2020**.
