

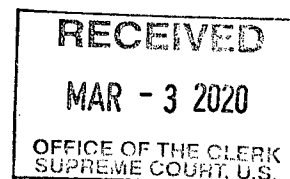

**PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

Comes Now Petitioner, Randolph Ashford, and respectfully request this court to grant a 60 day extension to petition for a writ of certiorari. In support of request, Petitioner states the following.

1. Petitioner, receive service of the Notice of judgement to dismiss dated October 25, 2019. nearly a week after it was filed.
2. Petitioner, filed a motion for extension of time to file for a rehearing on November 5th, 2019.
3. Petitioner, motion was granted extending the time frame to December 2, 2019.
