I represent respondent in the above-referenced petition for certiorari. A response is currently due on February 21, 2020. Respondent respectfully requests that the time to file a response be extended by 30 days, to and including March 23, 2020. The extension is warranted because the undersigned counsel, Mitchell P. Reich, was recently retained as counsel of record and must familiarize himself with the issues and record.
