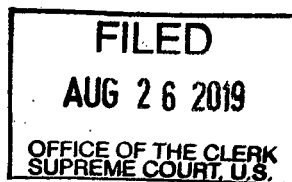

MOTION for an EXTENSION of TIME to file the writ of certiorari
