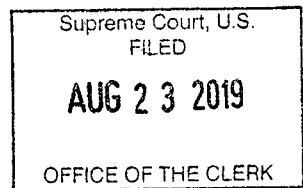

REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION – 60 DAYS

Dear Justice Kagan/Clerk of the Supreme Court,

I am Requesting for a 60 Day Extension. My name is Marco Gonzalez and I will be filing a Writ of Certiorari because I have been falsely convicted of being a Vexatious Litigant in the State of California.
