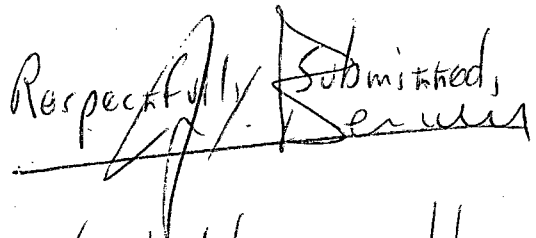
Please treat this letter as an application for an extension of time to file for a writ of Certiorari. Please forward to the Justice for the Second Circuit.

By Order dated June 26, 2019, the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit denied Petitioner's Motion To Recall the Mandate. The 90 days to file for certiorari will expire on September 24, 2019.

The basis for applying for an extension of time for sixty days, until November 23, 2019, is that FCI Allenwood was locked down on August 22, 2019. We were let out today and within an hour, we were locked down again, due to a further incident. Petitioner does not know when we will be released but will inform the Court of any further obstacle should the Court grant this requested extension.

On lockdown a prisoner can not access the law library to research and prepare pleadings. A prisoner can not access a typewriter to type pleadings and a prisoner can not access a copier to make any copies of documents. Thusly, a prisoner can not properly litigate.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court grant him an extension of time until November 23, 2019 in order to file a Writ of Certiorari for the Second Circuit Court of Appeals order dated June 26, 2019 denying a Motion To Recall the Mandate in the case of United States v Jean Bernier, 91-1370 renumbered 19-H-59 to configure within PACER.
