MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF

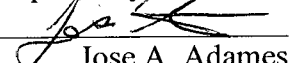
This Petitioner moves for an extension of time in which to file its brief in this case. The petitioner requests an extension of time thirty (30) days to October 16, 2019. This is undersigned counsel's first motion for an extension of time in this case. The grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. Petitioner hasn't been able to assist the institution law library on the regular base because of construction that is being done in the cell halls.
2. Petitioner is only able to assist the institution law library every other day only.
3. The time requested also reflects the time necessary for petitioner to complete the substance of the brief, and for petitioner to prepare the brief by cite-checking, record-checking, reviewing and copying said brief.

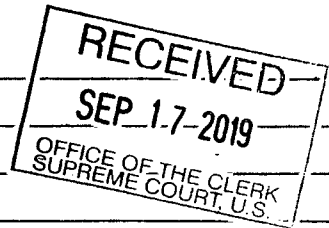
