MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Now appearing pro-se, in good faith, I Byron Tyrome Todd, respectfully tenders this instrument of truth under penalties of perjury in the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree pursuant 28USC 1746, and petitions this court to grant me a 60day extension. The following verified facts and laws support:

1. Pursuant SUPREME COURT RULE 13.5 although extensions are not favored ,I believe that because the law library has been closed for the majority of august and September, I haven't been able to have reasonable access to the courts.
2. This court has original jurisdiction to review the the states highest courts decision pursuant 28 USC 1251, article 3 of the UNITED STATES constitution, with 28 USC 1651 as additional jurisdiction.
