Please accept Petitioner Arthur Lopez's
Request For a 60 Day Extension to
File a Petition For Writ of Certiorari on this
case extending the current deadline
of September 17th, 2019 to November 18, 2019
(Monday as 11/16/19 lands on a Saturday).

This request is made with Good Cause and
necessary since The California Supreme Court
denied Petitioner's Petition for Review on June 19, 2019.

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To Begin, Petitioner continues to
Encounter delays, obstructions and artificial
barriers at every level of the judicial
processes in the Orange County, California
region. These include the Local Public Library,
Law Library and University (CSUF) Library
as well as the Superior Court, California
Court of Appeals and Family Superior Court.
In fact, the California Court of Appeals refuses
to accept Proof of Service signed by a
Pro-Se Litigant even when the lack of
employment income and permanent disabilities/
injuries are presented and a fee waiver is
granted. Moreover, if the O.C. Sheriff is
providing the Service of Documents they
require the Proof of Service to be presented
before the filings are accepted despite the
Sheriff requiring up to 10 days to deliver the
Proof of Service by mail. Recently under case
number L057379 a Request for Oral Argument
Time was presented by mail travel with a
Proof of Service signed by the Appellant Arthur Lopez
since no one else was available to serve
the copy upon the Respondent and meet the
filing deadline (within 15 Days of Notice to Submit
Request). This prompted a call from the clerk
of the court to Appellant indicating the Proof
of Service submitted would not be acceptable

1 and a new Proof of Service would be required
2 signed by a third party over 18 or the
3 O.C. Sheriff and filed within 10 Days.

4 However, the O.C. Sheriff does not operate
5 in such a prompt, guaranteed turn around
6 timeline making this expectation or demand
7 unrealistic and unattainable.

8 Nevertheless, these duplications of the
9 proof of service submittal and multiple
10 delivery of this single form creates a
11 huge drain of time to say the least
12 all the while every other California
13 jurisdiction / court including the California
14 Supreme Court freely accepts the
15 Proof of Service signed by the Pro Se
16 Litigant / appellant.

18 In addition, due to Petitioner's permanent
19 injuries a 9/12/19 doctor's visit / appointment
20 was met with Dr. Philip Madrid.

22 Lastly, Petitioner also met the deadline
23 established for Docket # 19A148 of August 17, 2019
24 and will fine tune the Petition as instructed
25 off the Clerk of the Court.
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1 For all these reasons and many more
2 Petitioner humbly seeks your honor's
3 granting of this 60 Day Extension to
4 file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari
5 extending the present deadline of
6 September 17th, 2019 to November 18th, 2019
