To the Honorable Sonia Sotomayor, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States and Circuit Justice for the Tenth Circuit:

Petitioner Pedro Jose Rosales-Trujillo prays for a 57-day extension of time, to and including December 5, 2019, in which to file his petition for writ of certiorari. In support of this request, counsel states as follows:

1. On July 11, 2019, the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit affirmed the judgment of the district court in this case. A copy of that opinion is an attachment to this application.

2. Mr. Rosales-Trujillo has ninety days from July 11 to petition for a writ of certiorari. Sup. Ct. R. 13.3. Ninety days from July 11 is October 9. This application is being filed at least ten days before October 9, 2019.

3. The jurisdiction of this Court is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

4. Since the beginning of August, I have filed the opening briefs in United States v. Trillo-Gonzalez, No. 19-2018 (10th Cir.), and United States v. Lovelace, No. 19-1100 (10th Cir.), the petition for initial hearing *en banc* in Lovelace, and the petition for writ of certiorari in United States v.

Bowline, No. 19-5563 (U.S.), and argued United States v. O’Neal, No. 18-1365 (10th Cir.), in the Tenth Circuit. I am now preparing a reply brief in United States v. Young, No. 18-6221 (10th Cir.), which must be filed by October 4. I therefore believe an extension of time will be needed adequately to prepare Mr. Rosales-Trujillo’s petition for writ of certiorari.

5. The requested extension is for fifty-seven days, to and including December 5, 2019. During the requested extension period, I am responsible for filing the opening briefs in United States v. Gilleland, No. 19-5025 (10th Cir.), and United States v. Osborn, No. 19-1276 (10th Cir.). I also anticipate that I will be responsible for filing the reply to the brief in opposition in Bowline, as the government is seeking an extension that would make the brief in opposition due on November 14.

WHEREFORE Pedro Jose Rosales-Trujillo respectfully requests that an order be entered extending his time in which to petition for certiorari by fifty-seven days, to and including December 5, 2019.
