Motion Requesting Extension of Time to File

Writ of Certiorari

Comes now Petitioner
(herein Butler) and pleads
for extension of time to file
Writ of Certiorari for the
reasons wherein:

I. Extension.

Butler received a dis-
missal for want of jurisdiction
the petition for review with
postcard of decision of 07/12/2019.
Butler then requested for a
hearing and was denied on
08/30/2019.

Therefore requesting an extension
to file Writ of Certiorari
whether from 07/12/2019 or
08/30/2019 from 90 days under
rule 30 to request extension
is requested as precautionary
to preserve time table.
