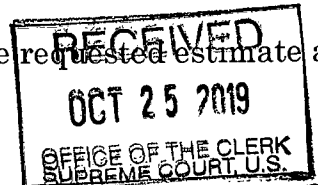
INTRODUCTION / STATEMENT OF FACTS

I have written two letters to the court. One on 10/17/19 seen as exhibit 1; the other written on 10/21/19, seen as exhibit 2. Today, I understand that neither letter directly address the necessary request for an extension of time to comply with the courts order of 10/7/19.

In exhibit 1, I prove what I did to fulfill my obligation regarding the notice and waiver form to the defendant (employer Macomb County).

In Exhibit 2, I testified that I discovered the 10/7/19 ordered on 10/19/2019 at about 2:30 PM; and Exhibit 2 is evidence of what I did after that discovery.

On 10/21/19, about 11:50 AM, I called Cockle Legal Briefs and explained the courts 10/7/19 ordered. I requested an estimate. I received the requested estimate at



3:24 PM that removed the proofreading of the brief and appendix. Knowing that there are mistakes that need to be corrected I needed to know what corrections I could make.

On 10/22/19 I called the United States Supreme Court clerk's office and was directed to Jeff Atkins. Mr. Atkins explained what could and could not be changed. With that information I called back to Cockle Legal Briefs and explained I wanted an estimate that did include the proofreading. I did receive a revised estimate, and an understanding that a 30 day extension would be sufficient time for Cockle Legal Briefs to complete the book form submission; allowing me the ability to comply with the 10/7/19 court order.
