

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

COMES NOW, Petitioner Marshall Henry Ellis, pro se, in the above numbered case and asks this Court to grant an extension of time of sixty (60) additional days to prepare a petition for writ of certiorari:

1. The Petitioner is a prisoner in the custody of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections and housed at the Lexington Assessment & Reception Center in Lexington, Oklahoma. He is subject to the rules of said institution.
2. The Petitioner is a lay person with no previous knowledge of legal procedure.
3. The Petitioner has spent (31) thirty-one days of the (90) ninety day time period for appeal subject to a statewide correctional system lockdown and has only been able to access and visit with law clerks on one occasion, for approximately three (3) hours, to date.
4. The legal library at the facility housing the Petitioner has only one (1) research computer and three (3) typing computers available to approximately 700+ inmates.
5. The purpose of this extension is not to unreasonably delay and is presented on good-faith basis.
