MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION
FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

COMES, the Petitioner, JOHN A. TOTH, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an Extension of Time to file a Petition For Writ of Certiorari, pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 30.2, 30.3, and 28 U.S.C. § 2101(c). The Petitioner has encountered extraordinary circumstances that has forced Mr. Toth to request of this Court an additional Forty-Five (45) days to file the Petition. In support, the Petitioner states the following:

- 1) The Petitioner's Habeas Corpus (11th Circuit Case No.: 18-11087-DD) was denied on June 13, 2019. Mr. Toth filed for Rehearing on July 2, 2019, which was denied August 14, 2019.
- 2) Mandate was issued on August 22, 2019 (see attached), and sent to Petitioner's place of incarceration; RMC-Work Camp, Lake Butler, Florida. Mr. Toth's Petition For Writ of Certiorari deadline is November 20, 2019.
- 3) While Mr. Toth was at RMC-Work Camp, he acquired the assistance of RMC-Main Unit Law Clerks to construct his Petition For Writ

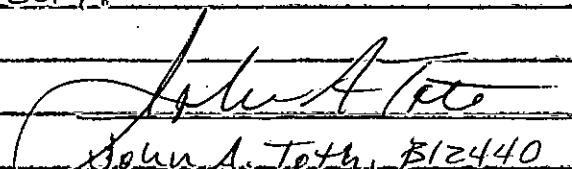
of Certiorari. Work Camp inmates must be transported to the Main Unit for use of Legal and Law Services and Research.

- 4) The Petitioner was transferred unexpectedly from RUC-Work Camp to Avon Park C.I., Avon Park, Florida, on October 28, 2019. Mr. Toth was unable to retrieve his partially constructed Petition and other Legal Paperwork/ Documents required to accompany the Petition in the Appendices. Subsequently, Mr. Toth has been informed it may take up to three (3) weeks in the forwarding of these materials.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner humbly requests an additional Forty-Five (45) days to submit his Petition For Writ of Certiorari, with the new due date becoming January 7, 2020.
