


Dear Ms. Houghteling:

Thank you for speaking with me today concerning your previous letter. I write in response to your letter dated November 5, 2019 wherein additional information is requested to determine my eligibility for an extension of time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari. Attached, please find the lower court's opinion from the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit, dated June 24, 2019. Please also find the Second Circuit's order denying my petition for panel rehearing or, in the alternative for rehearing en banc, dated August 29, 2019.

I humbly request an extension of time for 60 days from the November 27, 2019 original deadline for filing my writ of certiorari. I am currently incarcerated at a women's federal prison camp and have limited access to legal material and a typewriter. Specifically, we have only two typewriters for 160 women that are available only during set times each day. Moreover, my ability to do legal research for necessary case law, regarding restitution, has proven difficult with the system provided by the Bureau of Prisons. The system is two months delayed in reporting possible relevant case law required for my writ of certiorari. Further, the commissary had no typewriter ribbons for sale for six to eight weeks from approximately August 8, 2019 to November 4, 2019.
