PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME TO FILE A
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Petitioner files this motion asking the Court for 60 days
extention of time to file his petition for writ of certiorari.
The extention of time is needed for the following reasons :

Petitioner is a prose appellant who proceeded with this
litigation without the assistance of an attorney. This case
involves Civil Rights and Constitutional issues.

Because of the prose and forma pauperis status, petitioner
had no access to the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals' website, nor
to timely updates of said court's actions. The established
method of communication between the Fifth Circuit and the
petitioner was via U.S. Mail.

On November 21, 2019, petitioner asked the 5-th Circuit, via
certified mail to send petitioner a copy of the ruling that they

made about one month earlier and was never mailed to him.
A true and correct copy of said request is attached hereto as
Exhibit A.

Petitioner finally received a copy of the 5-th Circuit's
ruling on December 10, 2019.

For the reasons described above, petitioner asks the Court for
a 60 days extention of time to file his petition for a writ of
certiorari.
