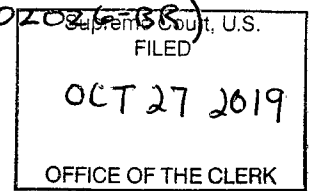
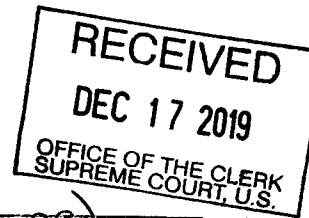

2nd MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR
WRIT OF CERTIORARI

- 1) On 1/23/19, I filed an Informal Opening Brief in the 4th Circuit Court of Appeals (COA) seeking review of the district court's dismissal of my habeas petition and denial of my certificate of appealability.
- 2) On 9/17/19, the COA dismissed my appeal and denied the certificate. (Ex. 1) On 10/1/19, I timely filed a petition for rehearing en banc by putting it in the prison mailbox with first class postage. It was received by the clerk's office on 10/8/19 (Ex. 2) and a STAY OF MANDATE was issued.
- 3) On 10/22/19 an order denying the petition for rehearing en banc was entered and on 10/30/19 a MANDATE was entered that activated the judgment "entered September 17, 2019". (Ex. 4)
- 4) I am not exactly sure when the tolling period for filing my P.W.C. with this Court expires, but I do know that this instant motion is timely.
- 5) I am an indigent inmate confined in an institution without access to a law library and N.C. Prisoner Legal Services does not provide inmates

with caselaws, legal research or assistance with post-conviction relief at the federal level. I was allowed to proceed in forma pauperis in both the district and appellate courts.

6) I am in the process of seeking professional representation from a law school in West Virginia, a D.C. law firm and the N.C. Center on Actual Innocence. All 3 entities are independently reviewing my file at this time, a process that could take several weeks.

7) If I am not successful at obtaining representation, I will be proceeding prose.

FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, I request the maximum extension allowed by Rule 13.5, 60 days, be added to my current expiration date.
