Comes now, Petitioner, pro se, and in forma pauperis, and hereby states the following:

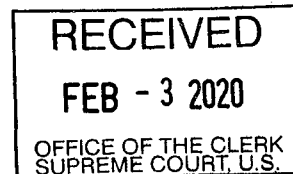
