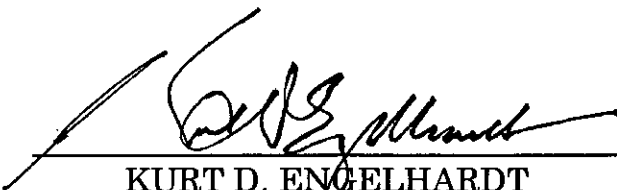

ORDER:

Erik Wilhelm Traczyk, Louisiana prisoner # 605489, moves for a certificate of appealability (COA) from the dismissal without prejudice of his 28 U.S.C. § 2254 applications. Traczyk is serving a life sentence for first degree murder. Traczyk's applications were deemed mixed applications because they contained both exhausted and unexhausted claims. Traczyk does not show that reasonable jurists would debate the district court's procedural ruling. *See Slack v. McDaniel*, 529 U.S. 473, 484 (2000). His motion for a COA is DENIED. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2). His motion to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal is also DENIED.
