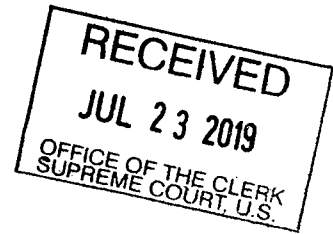


Dear Clerk,

I received your letter returning my application for an extension of dated July 3, 2019 last night July 9, 2019, stating I failed to append a copy of the order or opinion I am asking to be reviewed as required by Rule 23.3. I sencerely pray this most Honorable Court combine this application for an extension of time with the Motion to Stay Mandate I mailed to the court at the time I sent the application for an extension of time, July 19, 2019. The reason I make this request is that the administration here at Limestone Correctional Facility, 28779 Nick Davis Road, Harvest, Alabama 35749, have effectively shut down my ability to access the courts. Correspondence from this court is the only legal mail I have received in a reasonable time. Everything else is being held for weeks prior to being served to me. I cannot obtain any copies of legal documents. The only copies of the orders I seek to have the court review were attached to the Application to Stay Enforcement of Judgment. I was very fortunate to have those, the administration here vertually destroyed all my legal material upon arrival here Feb. 19, 2019. Feb. 20, 2019 my legal documents were burned.

I do have the judgment handed down by the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit in which rehearing was denied on May 9, 2019,(see attached).

I sincerely pray that this Most Honorable Court expedite this request as my 90 days allowed to petition for writ of certiorari is going to expire in 29 days. I desperately need additional time in my attempts to obtain the record that has been destroyed by the State of Alabama. First provided by the Alabama State Attorney General's Office and now destroyed by the state.
