Please accept Petitioner Arthur Lopez's First
Request for a 60 Day Extension to file
a Petition for Writ of Certiorari on this
matter / case related to the Denial by the
California Supreme Court of Petitioner's
"Petition for Review" of the Denial of
a Petition for Habeas Corpus by the
California Court of Appeals for the 4th District,
3rd Division. The California Supreme Court denied

1 said petition on November 20th, 2019 and
2 as such the deadline to file would be
3 Tuesday, February 18th, 2020 and the proposed new
4 due date, if your honor would grant this request,
5 would become Saturday, April 18th, 2020.

7 Moreover, this extension request is made with an abundance
8 of Good Cause since Petitioner continues to be
9 the target of harassment, obstruction / Delays, Deprivation
10 of Civil Rights and even Discrimination as a Catholic-
11 Christian / Male / Latino - Hispanic / Familial Status.
12 Those perpetrating these hostilities include the Superior
13 Court of California, County of Orange to the point of requiring
14 phone contact with the local F.B.I. office for relief
15 on or about December 13th, 2019 since the
16 Orange County Sheriffs on site and @ the Administration
17 Office claimed to be powerless to intervene
18 with the obstruction of Justice that when on
19 for hours barring petitioner from filing court
20 documents and pleadings ordered by the presiding judge
21 on a Civil Case involving the Irvine Company LLC, THE, et al,
22 Case # 30-2018-01000086. This being one of countless obstruction
23 incidents creating mountains of delays and duplicity of
24 procedures leading Petitioner in circles and deprived of
25 actual Due Process under Law - such as refusing
26 to accept proof of service signed by petitioner -
27 Pro-Se Litigant who by definition is indigent.
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In fact, these retaliatory hostilities are a standard business practice by the same entities and staff that warrants and necessitates the filing of this writ of certiorari to correct the wrongs/errors of the California lower courts including the Supreme Court who as a standard operating procedure/practice negate Petitioner / Minority Defendants the likes of Mexican Heritage - Hispanic Latinos and African-Americans to name just a few, of their United States Constitutional Civil Rights and in consequence creating false imprisonment, character assassination, and a blemished record that leads to decades of negative repercussions such as bias custody arrangements for petitioners minor children and many many more..

5 Furthermore, Plaintiff also has petitioned
6 relief from this Court related to the
7 deprivation of 14th amendment civil and Parental
8 rights involving the banning of all contact with
9 his four minor children for over four years,
10 all of which is under this court's docket # 19-7230,
11 a response from the Respondent is due by February 10th, 2020.
12 Furthermore, Plaintiff remains obligated to
13 fulfill orders from the California Court of Appeals
14 for several appeal matters involving Housing
15 Discrimination by the Irvine Company, The LLC, et al (#160588225)
16 and Family Court Case # 16D001283.
17 Lastly, Plaintiff remains with permanent
18 injuries permanent Disabilities that have and will continue to
19 require doctor visits as has been the case recently in
20 January and February 2020.

22 For all these reasons and more Plaintiff Arthur Lopez
23 humbly requests your honors granting of a 60 Day
24 Extension to file this Petition for Writ of Certiorari
25 from the current deadline of February 18, 2020 to
26 April 18, 2020.
