TIME PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI.


On March 18, 2020, Petitioner submitted his petition for a writ of certiorari to prison officials.

On March 19, 2020, prison officials postmarked the petition and mailed it to the supreme court of the United States ("SCOTUS"). The petition was received in the office of the clerk on March 24, 2020.

On March 31, 2020, the office of the clerk returned the petition to Petitioner, stating that the petition is, "Out-of-Time".

A petition is deemed filed at the time it was delivered to prison authorities for forwarding, Houston V. Lack, 487 U.S. 266 (1988)[Persuant to Fed.R.App. p.25(a)(2)(c), "A petition filed by an inmate confined in an institution is timely filed if deposited in the institution's internal mail system on or before the last day for filing."].

Petitioner does not dispute the fact that the petition was untimely. But due to extraordinary and compelling circumstances within the institution for the COVID-19 pandemic, and the ~~quarantine~~



tine lockdown, court materials such as typing, stamps, certification materials and envelopes were unavailable to Petitioner. Thus, for the foregoing reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests for leave of the court to submit the following petition persuant to rule 12.1, as an out-of-time petition, for consideration of the court.
