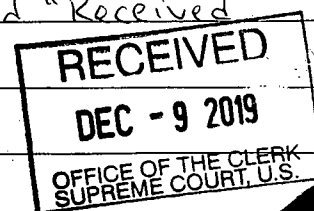

MOTION TO RESUBMIT PETITION "OUT-OF-TIME."

In this appeal from the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit, Mr. Conner petitioned this Honorable United States Supreme Court on August 31, 2018. The Clerk found that I had a August 29, 2018 deadline. This occurred after Mr. Conner wrote this Court for an extension due to Oxford Federal Correctional Institution being on lock-down status on August 14, 2018. Petitioner had limited access to his legal material. The Clerk provided that the Petitioner had until October 6, 2018 to file his timely petition. The Petitioner place his petition in the institution legal mail system on August 31, 2018.

On January 31, 2019, The Clerk directed the Petitioner to resubmit the corrected petition "out of time."

On February 12 or 13, 2019, the Petitioner placed his correct petition in the institution's legal mailing system. This Petition is marked "Received" by this Court February 21, 2019.



On August 8, 2019, the Petitioner wrote a letter seeking information on the February 12 or 13, 2019 submitted Petition.

On November 8, 2019, the Clerk responded to the Petitioner's letter postmarked August 8, 2019, declaring, "there is no record of this office having received your petition for a writ of Certiorari." Along with the direction to "resubmit the petition and motion again." (see App. 11)

Mr. Conner respectfully ask the Clerk to file the said Petition for a writ of Certiorari, "out-of-time."

ORDER
