Dear Mr. Harris:

I write to clarify Respondent's position concerning the motion filed in the abovecaptioned case on August 3, 2022 by 25 Harvard student and alumni organizations proceeding as amici curiae. That motion seeks "leave to participate in oral argument in support of Respondent, that the time allotted to each side be enlarged by 10 minutes, and that Amici Organizations be granted 10 minutes of oral argument time." "Alternatively," the motion requests that Amici "be granted up to 10 minutes of Respondent's oral argument time."

The motion states that "Respondent takes no position on this motion." To clarify Respondent's position, Respondent does not take a position with respect to Amici's primary request, under which argument time would be enlarged by 10 minutes on each side. Respondent opposes, however, Amici's alternative request that they be granted a portion of Respondent's oral argument time in the event argument time is not enlarged.
