The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on August 3, 2020. The government's response is now due, after three extensions, on December 2, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including December 3, 2020, within which to file a response.
